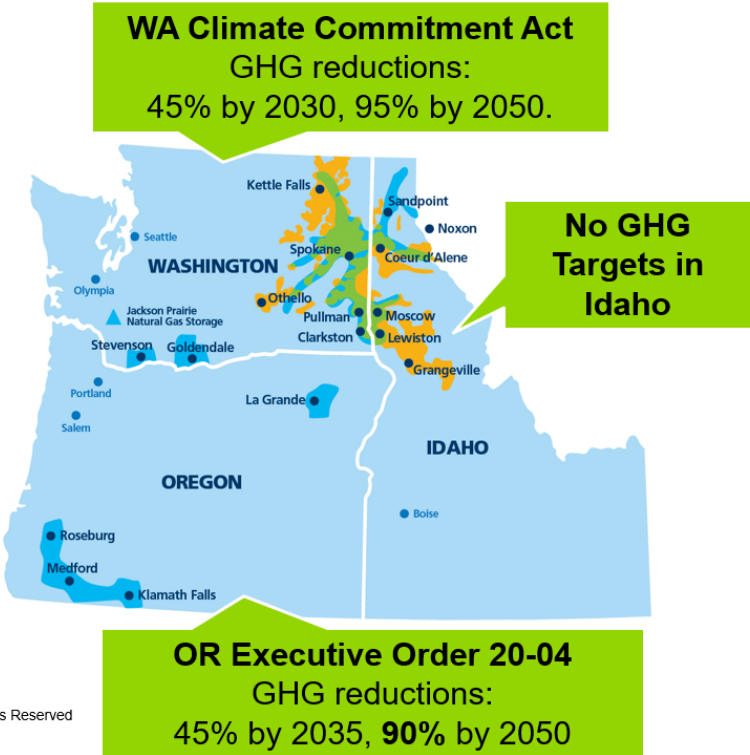
Policy and Regulatory Drivers Impact Regional Operations

*Legislation targets in Avista’s service area require CO2 reduction;
LDCs must demonstrate the role for low-carbon fuels*

Avista’s Natural Gas Emissions Reduction Goals	
2030	30% Reduction
2045	Carbon Neutral

GHG reduction options for Gas LDCs:

- 1 Sell less gas (via efficiency, electrification)
- 2 Reduce carbon intensity of gas system
- 3 Purchase carbon offsets
