Call before you dig: gas pipeline safety

To keep our natural gas system safe and reliable, Avista completes regular maintenance. We perform several safety procedures including, but not limited to, leak surveys, pipeline excavation monitoring, meter inspections and gas meter replacements.

Please know that, from time to time, you may see one of our workers in your yard performing these



maintenance actions. And remember, for home projects, state law requires you to call 811 at least two business days before you start digging.

Calling 811 will initiate a request for someone to visit your work site to mark the ground above utility lines. Customers can also request private locates for non-
