# Helping students start the school year strong: Operation School Bell

Back-to-school shopping is a milestone for many families, but for some, it's a financial burden. With average costs topping \$800 per student, nearly one in four children lack access to basic supplies.

In Klamath Falls, OR, the Assistance League of Klamath Basin is working to change that through its flagship program, Operation School Bell. Starting in late September, eligible students receive a \$135 shopping certificate to use at Fred Meyer, where discounts help stretch every dollar. Forty-one schools currently participate, with extra support available for graduating seniors.

Thanks to local partnerships and a recent grant from the Avista Foundation, the program continues to grow—reaching more students each year. These resources not only provide clothing and supplies but also boost students' confidence and readiness to learn, helping them feel valued and supported as they enter the classroom.

Founded in 1986, the League is a volunteer-run nonprofit with no paid staff. Members raise \$150,000 annually to support youth-focused initiatives including Children in Foster Care (CFC), which provides \$140 certificates to foster families, and Project USA, which funds the painting of large, colorful USA maps on playgrounds.

To support its mission year-round, the League operates Findables, a gently used furniture store whose proceeds benefit local youth programs.

# **Holiday cooking**

The kitchen is the heart of a home—especially during the holidays.

With increased activity and stress, it's important to prioritize natural gas safety.

Unattended cooking is the leading cause of fires. Keep your family and home safe by following these tips:

- **Storage:** Don't store combustible items in the oven (storage containers, etc.)
- **Keep it clean:** Make sure range and oven burners are clean and free from oven mitts, towels, etc.
- Don't block: Never cover appliance controls, air openings, or vents
- **Right tools:** Use the right tools and ensure pot handles are turned inward
- Follow instructions: Don't use gas range flames to heat a room or dry clothes
- Be prepared: Have a fire extinguisher nearby and know how to use it



- Check alarms: Make sure your smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are working properly
- Stay clear: Avoid loose clothing, spray cooking oil, and paper towels near an open flame
- Children and pets: Be aware of children and pets underfoot while cooking especially if control knobs are low and accessible to children




