
Did you know? Heating accounts for nearly half of your home's energy use in winter. Small changes can lead to big savings!

Try these simple tips to stay cozy and cut costs:

- **Seal leaks and drafts:** Use weatherstripping or caulk around windows and doors to keep warm air in and cold air out.
- **Consider adjusting your thermostat:** Try setting it a few degrees lower than usual when you're home and awake. You might also lower it a bit more when you're asleep or away to help save energy without sacrificing comfort. You can do this with the help of a smart thermostat.
- **Layer up:** Wear warm clothing indoors so you can comfortably lower your thermostat a few degrees.
- **Reverse ceiling fans:** Set them to spin clockwise (as viewed from below) to push warm air downward.
- Use space heaters wisely: Only heat the rooms you're using and turn them off when you leave.
- **Maintain your heating system:** Replace filters monthly and schedule regular checkups to keep it running efficiently.
- **Close unused rooms:** Shut doors and vents in rooms you don't use often to concentrate heat where it's needed.

Holiday lights

Twinkling lights are one of the joys of the season. Whether they're hanging from your home or strung on trees, those cheerful little lights are a delight for many, but improper use can cause fires, falls or electrical shocks.

To keep the holidays safe and fun, follow these safety tips while decorating:

- When decorating outside, use lights and extension cords that are approved for outdoor use.
- Inspect all light strands for damage and burned-out bulbs before decorating. Discard any strands with frayed insulation, exposed wires, or broken plugs. Always unplug the strand before replacing bulbs.
- Opt for miniature or LED **lights.** They use less energy and last longer. LED lights are also shatterproof and present less fire risk.
- Consider a timer to avoid leaving your lights on more than desired. Make sure the timer can handle the total wattage of your lights.
